Whe tremendous support weave received over the past 12 years from both the local and national business community has been instrumental in helping the NLCU Charitable Foundation reach its fundraising goals,+ said Allison Chaytor-Loveys, the Foundations president and CEO of Newfoundland and Labrador Credit Union (NLCU). RONA and Johnson Inc. sponsored three hole-in-one contests this year worth a combined value of \$45,000 to the first player lucky enough to sink a hole-in-one.
